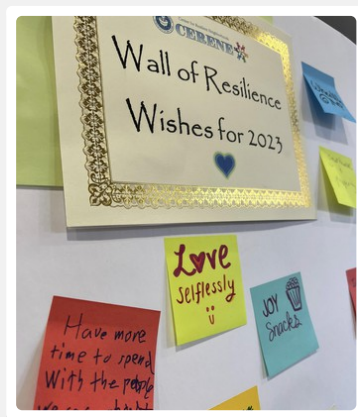
Sheltering in Place Kaiāulu Resilience Webinar w/ HI-EMA
